The following agencies were not present nor participating by phone: DOS, DOL, DOJ and FEMA.

The meeting began with introductions by the meeting attendees and telephonic participants. The Cochairs, Mr. Chris Field (EPA) and Mr. Mark Everett (USCG), provided an overview of the actions since the previous meeting in September 2014. Mr. Everett reviewed the proposed updates to the Biennial Work Plan.

Mr. Everett and Mr. Field opened discussion on proposed changes to the ARRT Charter. Discussion included concerns about balancing transparency and inclusion of the ARRT member agencies with decision-making and the need for efficiency and productivity. Other concerns raised included the timely communication of the responses to comments submitted and adequate review time of documents prior to meetings. A teleconference will be held at a later date to discuss the draft revisions to the charter, the comments received on the draft, and responses to the comments.

Mr. Nick Knowles (EPA) presented an overview of the upcoming Alaska Shield 2014 exercise scheduled to take place March 26-April 2, 2014. The exercise scenario will be a re-creation of the 1964 Good Friday earthquake and tsunami. The multi-agency exercise will include numerous venues in Alaska and the lower 48, including National Response Team (NRT) participation. ARRT involvement will include a notification and activation call for information purposes; however, the date and time of the call will be unannounced.

Status updates were provided for the following Working Groups, Task Forces and Committees:

- Endangered Species Act Consultation Workgroup (Update by Ms. Marcia Combes, EPA): The final Biological Assessment has been prepared and will be delivered to The US Fish and Wildlife Service, and the National Marine Fisheries Service (hereafter "the Services") by the first week of February 2014. The Biological Opinion from the Services is expected in summer 2014. Updates and revisions to the Unified Plan and Subarea Contingency Plans will be addressed at that time.
- <u>Cultural Resources Protection Committee</u> (Update by Ms. Pamela Bergman, DOI): The Cultural Resources Committee had no recent activity to report.

- Wildlife Protection Committee (Update by Ms. Pamela Bergman, DOI): The Wildlife Protection Committee has not held a recent meeting; however related committees or working groups have been active. The initial outreach for the update to the Wildlife Protection Guidelines for the Pribilof Islands has begun. This update will be Revision 8 and is expected to be completed this year. The CANUSDIX Wildlife Working Group has initiated updates to the CANUSDIX Wildlife Response Guidelines. This working group is not part of the ARRT. The CANUSDIX Resource Agency Working Group is working on an update to the CANUSDIX Guidelines for Resource Agency Input to Places of Refuge, Dispersant Use; and In-Situ Burning Decision-Making. Revisions to both are expected to be completed prior to Summer 2014 and will be submitted to the USCG and Canadian Coast Guard.
- <u>Tribal Engagement Task Force</u> (Update by Mr. Knowles, EPA): The Task Force has completed the draft *Guidelines for Coordination and Consultation with Federally-Recognized Tribes*. Comments from both the ARRT members and federally-recognized tribes have been incorporated and the guidance will next be submitted to EPA and USCG legal counsel for review. Ms. Bergman stated that DOI tribal specialists have some significant concerns with the guidance and asked for coordination with the task force work and the DOI staff to address their concerns.
- Regional Stakeholder Committee Workgroup (Update by Mr. Steve Russell, ADEC): A proposal to revise the Regional Stakeholder Committee is expected to be submitted to the ARRT at the May 2014 meeting.
- STC Dispersant Working Group (Update by CAPT Dan Travers, USCG): Tribal consultation and Stakeholder outreach meetings were held in November and December 2013. Additional meetings for Government-to-Government consultation are scheduled the first week of February, in conjunction with the Alaska Forum on the Environment conference. Comments on the draft plan are due February 15, 2014.
